**Suspended Animation.**

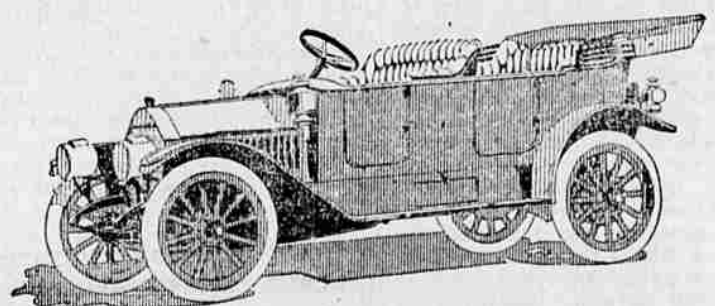
