Elgin is the only district in Union county that is paying any attention to registration for the primaries that pave the way for the general elections next fall. In every other precinct in the county save the two at Elgin there is deplorable lethargy. By April 9 all registrations to vote at the primaries must have been made, or the voter will have to be sworn in at the polls. Especially is this important this year where the general elections are concerned and the voter who will not register is distinctly derelict in his duties to the state and nation.

At Elgin about half the voting strength is registered and County Clerk Wright is encouraged at the prospects of getting at least one district well represented early. At the finish there will be a tremendous rush unless the matter is attended to now by at least some of the voters in the many precincts throughout the county.
