PETITION FOR CHANGE DENIED

RESOLUTION IS DENIED BY COMMISSIONERS.

Not Best, at This Time, to Change the Government.

The petition filed with the city clerk on January 20 by those citizens who wish to return to the old form of council government and asking an election on April 25 was rejected this morning by the city commissioners, says the Baker Herald of yesterday. The matter was brought before that body in the form of a resolution drawn up by the city attorney which express as the commissioners believed the sentiment of the majority of the citizens of Baker.

First of all, that it was not to the best interests of the citizens of Baker to call such an election at the time asked for, that it was detrimental to any city as well as extremely unfortunate for that city to be continually changing its form of government, also that since the present charter has been in force for so short a time and was chosen by a majority it was unwise that the proposed petition would hurt the credit of the city now offering so many bonds for purchase and also that a charter conceived as the petition proposed must be the result of some private motive and not the furthering of public interests.

After the reception of the petition Commissioner Finley made a short talk on the question of liquor licenses. He said that some believed them too high, others too low and that in his opinion they should be submitted to the people at the next general election for their decision. He also said that all agreed there were certain changes in the present charter that should be made and recommended the same course.

The commissioners adopted the opinion of the city attorney given to them at the last meeting without a dissenting vote.
