47 TO 10 SCORE GAME'S RECORD

BLUE AND WHITE RUNS AWAY FROM BAKER.

Decisive Victory for La Grande Fruit & Team Work.

La Grande invoked sweet vengeance for past defeats at the hands of Baker high last night at the high school gymnasium when the followers of the blue and white romped away from Baker in a contest replete with lightning plays to the melody of 47 to 10. Baker was able to cope with the home guard only for a period of the opening seven minutes and then La Grande caught her stride and fed baskets into the hopper with regularity that sometimes became monotonous. Baker shifted her players promiscuously but couldn't stop the scoring. Three field baskets and four free throws was the sum total of the visitor's tally, and all of the baskets were tossed from long and hard angles. Malone scored one sensational basket.

With precision in passing, lightning headwork and well systematized plays of attack, La Grande was able to play rings around the visitors and had the home team been able to register baskets with customary accuracy the score would have been much larger. So decisive, however, was the margin that the big audience went home in high glee for it is not every day in the year that La Grande can successfully match strength and agility with Baker—the jubilation is not bigotry by any means.

Followers of local basketball were surprised at the vim and aggressiveness of the locals. Spurts of the highest calibre of basketball were shown. In the first place, Bohnenkamp got over his man every time which allowed his colleagues to carry out their various plays without hindrance, for in basketball the secret of success in team work lies in the way the center gets the ball away for scrimmage. The scoring was pre-eminently the result of concentrated efforts by five men, yet Bolton was seen at his best, and probably played a better game than in any time in his career.

Woods didn't get his wicket eye agoing until the second half, but it is doubtful if any player wearing the La Grande colors was in as many needed places at the right time as his passing combined with agility in getting over the floor was responsible for most of the baskets that Bolton got. Captain Ralston and Lottes were almost faultless in their guarding, always on the aggressive but able to become defensive at a moment's notice—the essential requirement of a good guard. Every cog fitted in its place precisely and worked like a charm. With removal of minor flayed edges the team stands able to become well nigh perfection.
