STOCK REVIEW ENCOURAGING

HORSE BREEDERS BEND TOWARD STANDARD BRED.

No Contagion and Sales Continue With Lucrative Profits.

A mid-winter resume of the stock conditions throughout Union county

reveals a fine state of affairs—stock is healthy and contagion missing, sales are lively and prices good.

During the past 12 days, six carloads of draft horses have been bought up and shipped out. C. W. Hobcock sent a carload to Los Angeles, W. L. Skipton of Salem sent out a carload and C. W. Todd and G. W. Harrel of Portland got the others. The prices were up to standard, too, making a satisfactory deal all around.

Stock Wintered Well.

Dairy cattle are in fine condition. Young stock wintered well despite a few days of hard cold and deep snow. Practically without exception it can be said that the stock wintered exceptionally well.

Many Carloads Sold.

During the past 10 days alone 650 head of cattle have been shipped to Portland markets, Warren Chandler being the middleman who took the trouble of buying and handling the shipments.

The freedom of contagion in cattle herds as well as bands of horses is noticeable. Colt distemper has been reported occasionally but not in the numbers usually prevailing at this time of the year.

Standard Breeds Popular.

Horse fanciers are taking to standard bred types and that grade of horses is popular. There are now six standard bred stallions for public service in the valley and brood mares of the same type number between 12 and 15. As a consequence the breeding of light harness horses is in the ascendancy in this county. There is probably added interest in this branch of horse raising this year because of the probability of obtaining a good race track in the immediate future.
