'RIGHT OF WAY' COMING FEB. 16

SANFORD DODGE TO PRESENT
FAUST HERE, TOO.

Two-Night Stand at Steward Commencing February 16.

Sanford Dodge, oftentimes called the second Mansfield, is coming to La Grande February 16th and 17th, presenting "The Right of Way" and "Faust," two plays always entertaining when well rendered. Manager Steward has just received the final notice of Mr. Dodge's coming. The first night "The Right of Way" will be presented. The appended is of interest in relation to this well known piece:

Few plays have a stronger plot, with all the thrills which a cycle of events centering round the love, hate, trickery and deceit of a not over scrupulous man and woman than "The Right of Way" given at the Russell theatre last night by Sanford Dodge and his company.

The play is a dramatic version of the famous novel by Sir Gilbert Parker, bearing the same name as the play, and should be of more than ordinary interest here because the scenes are laid in Montreal and up in the lumber camps near here.

The difficult role of Charlie Steele, the disolute, profligate lawyer, whose agnosticism and cynicism spells danger and almost death was capably portrayed by Mr. Dodge.

Harry Bernard as the French Canadian lumber jack, Joe Portugals, who was saved from the gallows by Steele, was exceptionally good. He has the mannerisms, and dialect of a habitant lumber jack down to perfection.

Miss Adeline Nickerson, as the charming "Rosalie" demonstrating the solidity of a woman's love was delightful.

All the other actors handled their parts cleverly.

The story of the Right of Way is too well known to need repeating. The play will be given against this afternoon and tonight and should appeal to all who love a strong play with lots of local color on it. The scenery is new and very fine.
