## CITY FINANCE REPORT ISSUED

**BIG SUMS SPENT IN JULY AND AUGUST.**

City Assets Not Considered in the Statement of Finances.

Total indebtedness of the city of La Grande on January 1st, 1912, the expenditures of the city on the many departments, and a summarized statement is published today over the signature of the city auditor, N. J. Mansager.

While the total indebtedness comprising outstanding warrants and bonded indebtedness, totals \$363,339.59 less the \$26,000 cash on hand at the time of the statement, the statement does not carry with it any list of assets which the city controls and if an inventory balance were struck the indebtedness would of course be greatly reduced. Included in city assets which are not involved in this statement, are the city hall, the building occupied by the city offices, the tract of ground at Fourth and Pennsylvania the six acres on which is located the disposal tank, and various other properties throughout the city. The cost of paving is added to the general outlay of moneys shown in the statement.


