GASKELL WILL MAKE THE RACE

RANCHER TO TRY AND SECURE DEMOCRATIC NOMINATION.

Office of Sheriff Will Be Contested by Childers and Gaskell.

Fred Gaskell, well known throughout Union county as a prominent and successful rancher and a life-long democrat, announced today that he would enter the primaries in an endeavor to be nominated for the office of sheriff of Union county.

"There is not a particle of malice or criticism in my candidacy," said Mr. Gaskell to the Observer this afternoon. "I enter this race in the be-

lief that the farmers are entitled to a place on the ticket and think I can handle the work in a satisfactory manner."

Fred Gaskell was born in Michigan and when a mere child removed with his parents to Kansas where he learned in that old fashioned manner how to till the soil and work from 14 to 16 hours a day. He came to the Grande Ronde valley in 1886 and has resided here ever since. Fred belongs to the successful ranchers who have battled with the soil and came out victorious. His acquaintance extends over the entire valley and his standing here is first class.

Representative McKinley of Illinois, chairman of the republican congressional campaign committee, believes that the next house will have a republican majority of at least 80.
