The hay which was used to hide the tools was eaten away by a horse in the Briggs barn and when the owners came to feed more hay he found the tools at the bottom of the manger.

## COLLINS SHOT IN DEFENSE HE SAYS

CLAIMS HE WAS COLLECTING AN ACCOUNT.

Collins Is Arraigned at Baker—Goes to Grand Jury.

Howard Collins, the young man who attempted to kill the two Japs at Haines day before yesterday was given his preliminary hearing before Justice of the Peace W. L. Patterson yesterday afternoon. The charge made against him was assault with intent to kill. He waived examination and was bound over to the grand jury. The one Jap who was the worst hurt of the two, is getting along nicely and will soon be out of the hospital.

Collins claims that he came from La Grande the day of the shooting to collect some wages the Japs owed self defense. His bail was named in the sum of \$2,000, and may be given him, and says that he shot only in en, as his father, a Wallowa county rancher, who lives at Lostine, has been notified, and may sign the bonds for his release, until the grand jury meets, which will be week after next. Attorney Frank B. Mitchell of Haines will defend the young man.
