## MEMBERSHIP IS THRIVING

### LUTHERAN CHURCH HERE REVIVED WITH SUCCESS.

#### All Church Features to Be Carried Out by the Organization.

Another church, made up of interested and active membership, has been added to the church catalogue of La Grande—rather, perhaps, a church long dormant has been revived with new vigor of life. It is the Zion Evangelical church, made up of all tongues in view of the fact that neither the Germans nor Scandinavians have sufficient numbers to make a thriving congregation singly, but jointly and collectively can become great powers for good in La Grande.

The organization of the Lutherans of this city was effected on the 21st day of January, this year.

The new congregation has selected as its name "Zion's Evangelical Lutheran church." Sixty have this far signed the constitution and it is expected that the number will be raised to 90 or 100 before the charter is closed.

A Ladies' Parish Society has also been organized with 16 members, of which Mrs. Stageberg, 1507 Washington avenue, has been elected president. A Sunday school will also be organized soon in which the S. S. literature of the Lutheran grade system, known also as the Twentieth Century Graded System shall be used.

The Lutheran denomination in this country has a membership of 2,281,382 with 8,671 ministers. It has twenty-seven theological seminaries, 42 colleges, 52 academies, eight ladies' colleges and seminaries, 64 orphan's homes, 35 homes for aged, 9 deaconess motherhouses, 44 hospitals, 22 immigrant and seamen's missions, besides a number of other "Inner Mission" institutions—all the larger cities of our country. The Lutheran church in the world has a membership of 75,000,000 embracing one half of Protestantism.
