DINNER CROWD TO HEAR REPORT

LA GRANDE BOYS RETURN FROM WALLA WALLA MEET.

Men and Religion Forward Movement Will Be Talked Friday Night.

Friday evening of this week, a banquet will be served in the basement of the Baptist church, 25 cents per plate—at which time every man and boy in the city is invited to attend and hear the report of the men and boys who attended the Men and Religion Forward movement conference which was held last week at Walla Walla.

This Forward movement is spreading like wildfire throughout this country. "If you have overlooked what is going on in other places, come out Friday evening and hear the details," say the promoters.

It is the intention to hold a similar convention in this city in the near future and no doubt steps to start an immediate campaign at this meeting will be taken.

It will be noted that only men and boys are eligible to become members. The boy problem, which is considered in all religious undertakings, seems to have been solved in a measure.

This may be the foundation that may lead to the organization of a Y. M. C. A. in the city. There apparently is no limitation upon such an organization properly directed.

"Come out Friday evening and bring the boys. If you have no boy of your own invite somebody else's boy."

"Remember the date, the place, the banquet and the object of the meeting," said the publicity committee today.
