LIME-SULPHUR SPRAY IS BEST

EASTERN GREGON ORCHARDS NEED SUCH EMULSION.

Horticulturist Writes of Best Spray to Be Used Locally.

Union, March 13.—(Special)—Only within the last few years has the lime sulphur spray come before the eyes of the fruit grower in the right light. Before this time it was considered inferior to many of our other spray solutions, some of which it has now almost entirely replaced, at least for some diseases.

The method and formula for the preparation of the lime sulphur as it is now prepared and used is of quite recent origin. In 1908 A. B. Cordley of the Oregon Agricultural College made public this method of preparation and it has now practically replaced all former methods.

Every orchard should be given an annual application of this spray for it will do more to clean up a neglected orchard than any other one spray. Some of the troubles which may be controlled by this spray applied during the dormant season are: San Jose scale, Oystershell scale, all of the aphids, pear leaf blister mite, the hibernating larvae of the prune twig miner and bud moth, together with almost all other insects which may be found upon the trees during the winter and if applied to peach trees in the spring before the buds open it prevents peach leaf curl. It is both a fungicide and an insecticide and when properly diluted may be applied either during the growing or dormant period of the plant. As a summer spray when properly diluted it prevents apple scab and Downey mildew without the danger of injury to the foliage which so often accompanies the use of Bordeaux.

While lime-sulphur has been used successfully on all of the above troubles the one with which its use realizes the most benefit is in the control of the San Jose scale. This insect can be almost completely controlled by an annual application of lime-sulphur spray applied in the spring just before the buds open. By applying the spray at this time almost all of the scales are destroyed but if some escape another application in the fall after the leaves drop may be of considerable value in controlling this pest. These applications will also kill the eggs of the Woolly Green, Black and Brown aphids.

There are two general ways of securing this spray, by making the stock solution (for the stock solution method is best) at home or by buying it from some reliable firm and diluting it according to its density and the season of the year when it is to be used. For a stock solution which registers 30 degree Baume, for winter strength it should be diluted 1-10,

and for every two degrees decrease in density it should be composed of one part less water; thus, a stock solution registering 28 degrees Baume should be diluted 1-9, etc. For summer use, a solution registering 30 degrees Baume should be diluted 1-28 and one part less water should be added for a decrease of every one degree in the density of the stock solution.

Unless one has a large orchard and can use several barrels of the stock solution it is generally considered best to buy it in the commercial form. However, the home-made spray is equally as good if properly prepared and can often be made much cheaper.

This spray should be applied in the form of a mist which is best obtained by the maintenance of a high pressure. The whole surface of the tree should be given a thorough wetting and a quiet day should be selected to do this. A complete description of the methods of preparing and applying this spray is given in Bulletin 168 of the Experiment station at Corvallis, which may be had for the asking. The dates given in this bulletin are about a week too early for Eastern Oregon, but as far as known now, are right otherwise.

In conclusion we can say that an annual application should be given every orchard and the best time to apply it is in the spring just before the buds open. Of course it cannot cure or prevent every disease known but there is untold wealth hidden in its proper application and those who made use of it will reap the benefits.

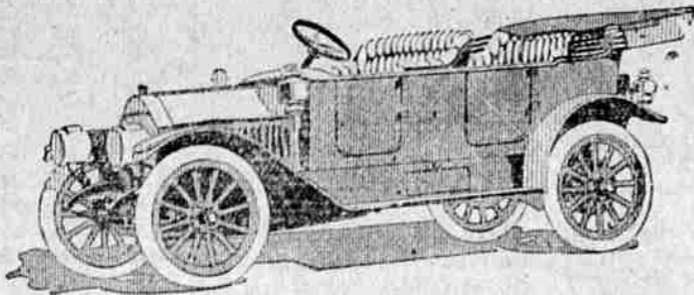
