CUT THIS OUT AND PASTE IT IN YOUR SCRAP BOOK: Slice off some of our fine sugar cured ham or bacon, quite thin. After taking off the rind put the slices into a hot frying pan, turning them over till they are crisp, but taking care not to burn them. About three minutes will do but it is necessary that the slices be cooked till they are absolutely crisp. This method brings out the delicate flavor of our bacon and ham, and, if served with eggs fried in the gravy, makes a dish fit for a king.
