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 by putting your plumbing in first-class sanitary condition, connecting it to sewer so it will pass all sanitary laws

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**Ordinance No. 554, Series 1911**  
 An Ordinance declaring the cost of improving Sixth street from the North line of K Avenue to the South line of Washington Avenue; determining the property benefitted thereby; levying a re-assessment thereon to defray the costs and expenses of the improvement; providing for the assessment roll of the same and directing the entry of said re-assessment in the docket of City Liens; providing a time when the same shall become delinquent and requiring the City Recorder to prepare a special assessment roll in accordance with the re-assessment herein levied and to collect said re-assessment.

WHEREAS, the former assessment for the purposes set forth in the title to this Ordinance has been set aside by an order of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for Union County; and,

WHEREAS, the council now desires to cause a new assessment to be made in the manner provided by the Charter for the same purposes as the former assessment was made, for the collection of the amount so assessed;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon the council by the charter of the city of La Grande to the effect that if any assessment is set aside by order of any Court, the Council may cause a new one to be made in like manner for the same purposes for the collection of the amount so assessed.

The City of La Grande Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the Council has considered the proposed re-assessment of the property benefitted by the improvement of Sixth Street from the North line of K Avenue to the South line of Washington Avenue and all thereto, and hereby ascertains and determines and declares the whole cost of said improvement in the manner provided by resolution duly passed by the Council on the 17th day of June, 1910, to be the sum of \$28,561.12, and the property hereafter described is specially benefitted by said improvement, and the special and peculiar benefits accruing to each lot or parcel thereof, or parcel of land within the assessment district and which is also specially benefitted by reason of said improvement, and which has been equitably apportioned among all blocks, lots, parts of blocks and lots, lands and real estate bounding, abutting, contiguous, fronting and adjacent and tributary to such improvement and within the district created for the purpose of making such improvement to the extent of the benefits to such lots, parts of lots, lands and real estate by reason of such improvement, and in no case in excess of said benefits, and the amounts set opposite the description or number of each lot or parcel thereof or parcel of land for which said respective parcels are assessed, is as follows:

Said application to be made under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 5, Title 26 of Lord's Oregon Laws.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the mayor, and published in one issue of the Evening Observer.
