The Boys' Club.
We men are living today in an age of "delayed boyhood." When we were young there were no clubs for us to join. The is that now we are crazy to "join something," with the result, quite often, that we join too many lodges. Because of this lack of early training the average lodge man has a very poor understanding of how to conduct a business meeting. Again, because of a lack of training in early days in God and the Bible the average lodge man joins and order, and I believe that all of the stronger orders are based on a belief in a Supreme Being, without thoroughly understanding what they are doing. Every present day boys' club should have as one of its main activities Bible study.

As a Unit.
A boys' club is often a thing apart depending upon itself. To be of the greatest value it should be a unit of something greater. A city with but two or three clubs would find it of great value to affiliate.

Of Associated Boys' Clubs.
Every city has its problems and should attempt to meet them. So also every club of boys has its problems. What we need in this section is for the boys' clubs to get together for a mutual exchange of methods. It is absolutely foolish to struggle as a separate club when so great an opportunity is offered to us to organize an associated boys' club.

Northeast Oregon—Southern Washburn
The geographical situation of this

territory lends itself well to such an organization. Southern Idaho, western Oregon and Southern Oregon have such an organization. Walla Walla is taking steps toward such an organization as suggested above. Fellows of Union and Wallowa counties, will we fall into line. It means better boys' clubs and thus better men.
