DOING NOTHING.

"Fifty per cent of the children doing absolutely nothing," is rather a startling statement in the report of the recreation survey made by the board of education and child welfare commission of Milwaukee. A play expert of the national recreation association—Rowland Haynes—formerly a specialist in psychology, spent several weeks in making the study. Information was gathered as to what the children in a given district were doing on Saturday and after school hours. It was found that 19 per cent were working, 31 per cent playing and 50 per cent were doing absolutely nothing. It is believed that these facts gathered in Milwaukee are fairly typical and present a strong argument for the necessity of providing adequate playgrounds for children. "Doing nothing" is tremendously dulling and results in filling up the juvenile courts.

A Hard Blow.
The Live Wire, republican paper of Pendleton, editorially prints an editorial of a Portland paper in part as follows:

"Judge Ellis ought not to be nomi-

nated. He ought not to be elected.

"He is a standpatter. He is a Joe Cannon republican. He was run by Cannon, voted by Cannon and bossed by Cannon.

"Cannon voted him for everything that Big Business wanted, and against everything that savored of progressiveness. Cannon voted him for the trusts, and voted him against every measure that proposed reduction of the high cost of living.

"Cannon was his master and his idol. Cannon breathed the breath of political action into him, and corked or uncorked him, at will. When Cannon's thumbs went up, and when Cannon non order 'thumbs up' Judge Ellis' ordered 'thumbs down,' Judge Ellis' thumbs went down.

"Judge Ellis is a genial gentleman, but in congress he was Cannon's pawn. Cannon moved him here or moved him there, and Judge Ellis always stayed put.

Irrigation Fund Lost.

Of all the men in congress he was in a position to prevent the change but nobody knows, nobody has ever heard, why he permitted it to go unchallenged."
