Final action on the matter of the city sewer in front of the J. H. Pearce property east of the city has been deferred another month when the county court continued the proposition for the term yesterday. The county judge and commissioners visited the scene of contention and will take final action a month hence. The sewer abutting the Pearce property is above the level of the highway, necessarily so to reach the septic tank at the proper grade and elevation.

Issuance of a franchise and right of way for the Grande Ronde Irrigation company was made yesterday after the company officials presented their requests and supplied certain contracts.

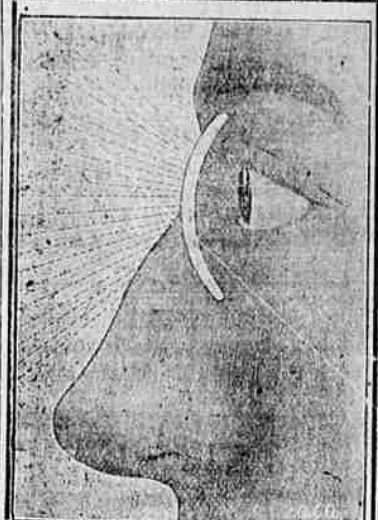
Court has adjourned for the term.

#### DEMURRER OVERRULED

May 10th Set as Day for Defendants to Answer Restraining Suit.

Circuit Judge J. W. Knowles yesterday denied the demurrer to the action brought by the Pioneer Flouring Mill company against the city of La Grande to restrain the city from using waters of Beaver creek for municipal water purposes. This action was commenced some time ago and the city filed a demurrer which has been overruled and the court allowed the city until May 10th to answer.
