WARDEN ORDERS FISH SCREENS

FISH MASTER TAKES STEPS TO PROTECT FISH.

Simple Instructions for Making the Screens Issued by State.

Simple instructions which if followed out will facilitate the conservation and protection of fish rather than the destruction of fish through carelessness in the manner of handling irrigation screens, are contained in an official notice to the public at large just issued by the state fish warden and Deputy Chas. B. Oral. The instructions and warning also, follows:

Owners of irrigating ditches, canals or mill races are hereby notified that the general laws of 1909 require all owners of irrigating ditches, canals or mill races, taking water from any river, creek or lake in the state of Oregon, in which fish have been placed or may exist, to install and maintain at the inlet of such ditch, canal or mill race, a wire screen or grating that will successfully prevent any fish from entering same. That the screen is required to be made of what is called a fifty inch mesh. The owners are given 30 days in which to comply with this law.

For the benefit of those who do not know what kind of a screen to place in position, it will be well to state that a rolling screen will be self cleaning and at the same time prevent fish from entering ditches, canals or mill races. They may make this to revolve against the stream by placing a paddle wheel behind the screen, put a wooden pulley upon the shaft of each, connect the pulleys by belt or a piece of rope,

crossing the belt or rope so that it pulls from the paddle wheel opposite to that of the screen. A piece of gas pipe makes the best shaft or axle for this work. First of all, there should be a head gate in the ditch, canal or mill race, then install the screen and paddle wheel. This will give satisfactory results to all concerned.

The law regarding this matter will be strictly enforced this year and the delinquent owner will be prosecuted as the law provides.
