### AUTO PEOPLE ACT.

#### Aim to Keep all Vehicles on the Right in Rounding Curves.

Petitions signed by a big majority of members of the Union County Motor club were filed with the city council last night, praying for a change in the speed limits and starting a campaign of education requiring vehicles of all kinds to keep to the right inturning corners.

The motor club points out that while no accidents have yet happened there is, nevertheless, a carelessness which may lead to serious injuries to some. Neither automobile owners or ordinary vehicles regard the law of keeping to the right in rounding the curves. This means all vehicles moving one way on each side of the street and would alleviate the dangers of accidents. The speed limit recommended is 15 miles an hour.

#### Passenger Train Attacked.

Nogales, Ariz., April 18.—For the third time within 10 days insurgents today attacked the West Coast passenger train 10 miles below Guaymas, Mex., firing several volleys of shots into the cab, through windows of the pullman coaches. It is believed no one was injured.

### Door Claims Innocence.

Stockton, Cal., April 18.—Although Chief of Police Briare declares he has sufficient evidence to convict William A. Door on a charge of murdering Geo. E. Marsh, a millionaire soap manufacturer of Lynn, Mass., Dorr, under arrest here, maintains his innocence. The prisoner denied he was farther east than Chicago. Door professed surprise when told he is being held for the Marsh murder.

### Mrs. Smith Mourns.

Southampton, England, April 18.—The following statement has been issued by Mrs. Eleanor Smith, the widow of Captain E. J. Smith, of the Titanic, who went down with his ship: "To my fellow sufferers: My heart overflows with grief for you. I am laden with sorrow for you and weighed down by this terrible misfortune which has been thrust upon us. Pray to God. He will comfort us all."

### Italian Fleet Active.

Constantinople, April 18.—The Italian fleet, according to reports received here is at the entrance to the Dardanelles and is believed to be preparing to force a passage. It is also reported that one Italian warship has struck a mine and went down.
