AIMS TO SPEND FEW DAYS HERE STUDYING Y. M. C. A.

"Erection of a Building" Campaign to Be Left to the Organizer.

I. B. Rhodes, secretary and field worker for the Oregon Y. M. C. A., will spend a week in La Grande early in May, laying plans for the Y. M. C. A. building campaign in this city. After he has been here and felt the public pulse he will announce the date of the opening gun in the campaign which many local boosters steadfastly believe will be immediately after the conclusion of his state. Y. M. C. A. in all its phases was the theme of a meeting of the Young Men's club at the Baptist church held last night in conjunction with a meeting of the Civic Religious federation and the outcome of the discussion was that Mr. Rhodes' offer to come to La Grande early in May be accepted and the organizer will personally look over the field here carefully. This will be during the lifetime of the campaign in Pendleton where a \$30,000 Y. M. C. A. is going up this spring.
