DISTRICT'S VOTE COMPILED

MEN RUNNING IN TWO COUNTIES GET TOTALS.

Big Majorities Is the Rule in All Joint Races, This District.

Total votes cast for joint senators and representatives on the republican and democratic tickets in Union and Wallowa counties have now been compiled. For joint senator on the republican ticket, Flagg polled 715, Kiddle 1207, a majority for Kiddle of 492.

For joint senator, Oliver polled 484 and Hodgkin 621, a majority for Hodgkin of 137.

For joint representative, republican ticket, McDonald polled 1392 and Runnells 428, a majority for McDonald of 964. The total vote cast in Wallowa county follows:
