**IRISH HUNTERS  
IN SELLS-FLOTO**

**CLASSY JUMPERS COME WITH BIG CIRCUS.**

High Class Hunters Imported From Ireland for Circus Ring.

The most attractive feature of the average traveling horse show is usually the exhibition made by the hunters and jumpers, and indeed when looking over the program, more often than not it is found that the most important prize money is devoted to these classes.

This season, the Sells-Floto circus, which comes here on Friday, June 7, for one day's engagement, are bringing with them several high class hunters, some of which have been especially imported from Ireland, and during the regular performance these clever animals give a very remarkable exhibition of timber topping. One of them, a black horse called "Lockett" is a thoroughbred raised on the ranch of the late Lucy Baldwin near Los Angeles, and which, with his weight up, ran a mile in 1:38 1/2 over the Santa Anita race track. "Lockett" was sold because his temper became so bad that he refused to face the barrier, and was regarded as absolutely useless from every standpoint.

Since he has been acquired by the Sells-Floto people, however, and under the skillful tutelage of Rhoda Royal, he has become one of the most docile horses with the show and jumps an obstacle nearly seven feet high with perfect ease. Last winter he won several prizes in the high jumping classes at Kansas City, Denver, Louisville and other big horse shows.
