LA GRANDE DISTRICT SETS NEW PRECEDENT.

Baker Meeting of Epworth Leaguers Will Be Interesting.

Not all sections of the country are trained to the value of the Epworth League institute as a training school for young Methodism. Some districts are so scattered that at first an institute such as is conducted from the central office seems entirely out of reach. The La Grande district with an area equal to the state of Ohio held a convention last fall at Union, Oregon, in which were introduced institute methods on a simple scale. This year the call comes for an institute. The expense of a central office institute proved a greater burden than we felt we could bear so we decided to conduct an institute in which we are to have instructors from our own section of the country. They are all strong workers in their particular branches of instruction. During our sessions we are to have with us as instructors or speakers the following: Dr. E. B. From all reports a large delegation will be present at Baker, Oregon, June 5-6 to enjoy this splendid institute given under the supervision of the La Grande District Epworth League.


