Trial of New Dreadnaught.

Washington, D. C., June 4.—Naval officers are looking forward with much interest to the results of the builder's trial of the battleship Arkansas, which are to begin today over the Rockland naval course. The Arkansas was built by the New York Shipbuilding company, at Camden, N. J., and is the largest completed dreadnaught in the world. The trials will occupy about ten days and it is

expected the giant war vessel will establish a new world's record for speed. She is equipped with turbine engines and carries a crew of 500 men. It is said to be the first trial trip of a war vessel on which life-boat room is provided for everyone on board.

To Celebrate Long Peace.

Ottawa, Ont., June 4.—At a meeting here today of men prominent in

financial, commercial and public affairs of Canada the preliminary steps were taken for the organization of a committee to co-operate with similar committees representing Great Britain and the United States in arranging for the proposed celebration of the completion of 100 years of peace between the United States and Canada.

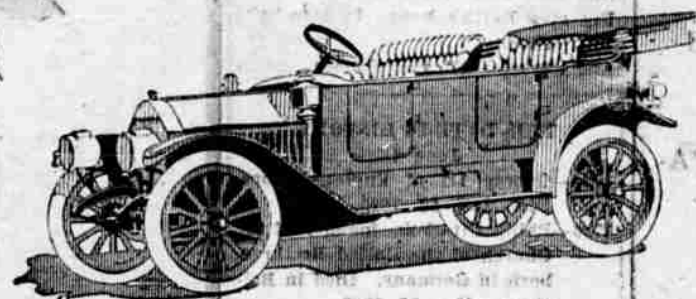
