LEAGUERS GO TO BAKER TODAY

BIGGEST CONVENTION OF ITS KIND IS TO BE HELD.
Local People Leave Today for Scene of Two-Days' Convention.

Local members and friends of the Epworth League of the Methodist church, leave today for Baker where the biggest district gathering of its kind in the history of Methodism in Eastern Oregon will be held tomorrow and Friday. J. H. Rudd, president of the district left this morning for Baker in company with Rev. H. S. Hamilton of Alice, but the main bulk of the delegates and participants leave this afternoon on the "Pony." Rev. J. D. Gillilan, D. D., is among the speakers on the program. Other speakers to be heard come from far and near and both in numbers and in importance the event is a precedent in this section of the state.
