FIVE INDICTED BY GRAND JURY

TWO NOT TRUE BILLS ARE ALSO RETURNED.

Warrants Not Issued but Hobson Is Supposed to Be One of Them.

Five true bills and two not true bills were reported in by the grand jury last night but all are secret. It is thought, however, that T. Hobson, the Elgin eloper is among the indicted but warrants have not been issued in any of the indictments up to date. The not true bills deal with two minor cases, defendants who have not been in the city since the time the cases were carried over to the grand jury. Because a recess exists today there will be no warrants issued, hence no publicity to the names of the indicted until tomorrow or thereafter as soon as the returns are made. The grand jury has not been excused.

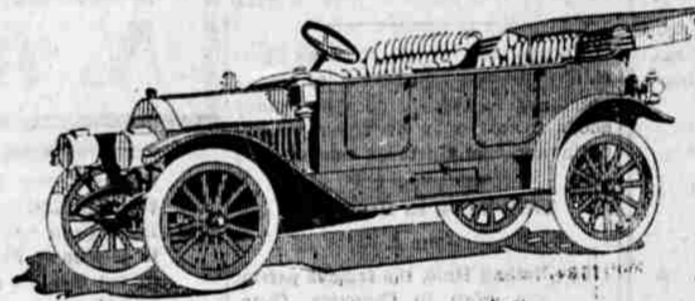
