

# CONFERENCE AT UNION BIG

FOUR HUNDRED AND MORE TO  
ATTEND FUNCTIONS.

Missionary Conference to Be Stellar  
Church Event Tomorrow.

Tomorrow the regular quarterly conference of the L. D. S. (Mormon) church will convene at Union. For many years these general conferences of the Union stake have been held in this city but to encourage the stock show and to show appreciation of the Union members of this church it was decided to hold it in Union where a huge tent has been erected and every preparation made for the comfort of visiting members. It is reported by the bishop at Union that every house has been canvassed and that sleeping accommodations have been prepared for four hundred so that visitors from here, Baker, Imbler, Cove and other places will be well cared for.

Bishop Hanks, with others, has devoted much time to make things pleasant for all who go. A special train will leave here on Sunday at 8:30 a. m. and the La Grande choir under the leadership of Prof. W. K. Davis will go in a whole and on Sunday afternoon and evening a choir of 150 voices, including Union and La Grande will render some excellent music. A splendid time is anticipated.

**Knights of the Maccabees Meet.**  
Frederick, Md., June 7.—The flourishing condition of the Knights of the Maccabees in Maryland was evidenced by the large number of delegates and visitors on hand today at the opening of the annual grand council session in this city. The program of the convention covers two days and

provides for several features of entertainment in addition to the regular business of the organization.

### Thousands Attend Unveiling.

Washington, D. C., June 7.—A number of special trains reached the capital today with delegations to attend the unveiling of the great Columbus memorial recently erected on the plaza in front of the union station. The unveiling will take place tomorrow and the event promises to be one of the most notable of its kind that has ever taken place in this country. It is conservatively estimated that 100,000 visitors will be in attendance. They are on their way from every section of the United States and Canada. The most of them are members of the Knights of Columbus, which organization is to have charge of the ceremonies of the day.

The unveiling is to be preceded by a monster street parade, which is expected to equal in numerical importance the presidential inauguration pageants. In addition to the Knights of Columbus and representatives of other civic bodies the marchers will include thousands of soldiers, sailors and marines. Gen. R. K. Evans, chief of the militia department of the war department, will act as grand marshal.

Secretary of State Knox will preside at the unveiling ceremonies. The invocation will be by Rt. Rev. Mgr. Thomas Shahan, rector of the Catholic University of America. The initial address will be delivered by Chief Justice Victor J. Dowling of the supreme court of the state of New York; Marquis Cusani Confalonieri, Italian ambassador to the United States, will unveil the statue. President Taft will then address the assemblage, as will also Representative James T. McCleary, who was instrumental in having the Columbus memorial bill passed by congress. The United States marine will intersperse the program with musical selections.
