INSTITUTE IS DESCRIBED

While the Epworth League institute is not an original idea with him, yet it was the fertile and constructive brain of Mr. H. Rudd of La Grande and Island City that conceived the thing as practical for our region. It was no small undertaking and was an innovation for us. We had had conventions and other similar gatherings but the institute was new. The difference between the convention proper and this lies in the fact that in the former all the sessions are open and general while these have their meetings in separate rooms and apartments, each presided over by an instructor who teaches and lectures to students and note-takers on specific lines.

The first institute has just concluded its sessions at Baker. Mr. Rudd was the president (now re-elected) and his conductors in the faculty were the following persons: Mr. T. A. Blaby of Boise conducted the "First Department", of which, Rev. W. S. Miller of Flora is the head; Rev. H. S. Hamilton of Alsea was the able instructor of the "Second Department", of which Miss Nellie C. Johnson is the head. While the first is on the devotional and evangelical part of the program work, this second concerns education, or the missionary idea. Miss Edna Breakenridge, a graduate of the University of Oregon, was the lecturer in the "Third Department" Mrs. H. C. Vinacke, head of this arm of the service. Both of these ladies are La Grande people. Dr. J. D. Gilliam had charge of the "Fourth Department." Miss Ruth Winters of Union the department head. Its office is to instruct in social and literary work and activity. Dr. G. G. Haley has the "General League Administration." Miss Letitia Thompson of Union being secretary in charge. Mrs. W. A. Winters of Union had joint administration with Rev. C. L. Walker of Haines in the Junior Department, with Miss Ada Lay of Joseph and Mr. R. W. Foulds directors. The next meeting is to be held in Joseph. La Grande made a strong run for the prize but had not enough votes.

Our delegates were Misses Sherman, Loeffel, Mrs. Lewth, Mrs. Vinacke, Miss Breakenridge and Miss Harvey.

On Sunday Rev. E. B. Fyke of Boise preached the sermons of the day, both morning and evening.

The officials elected for the coming and current year are: J. H. Rudd, La Grande, president; Rev. W. S. Miller, Flora, first vice-president; Miss Nellie C. Johnson, John Day, second vice-president; Mrs. N. V. Vinacke, La Grande, third vice-president; Robert Williams, Cove, fourth vice-president; Miss Letitia Thompson, Union, Secretary and Rev. H. E. Bush, Nyssa, treasurer.
