All that portion of North Second street, from the north line of W avenue, to the center of Lake avenue.

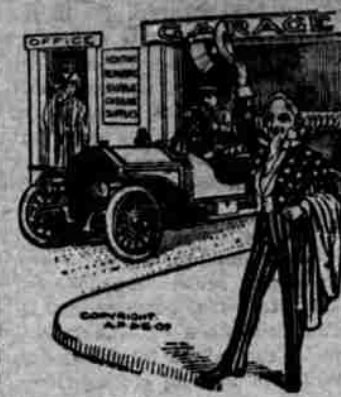
