A party of Union people headed by Tom Wright, the veteran banker of Union, attended the chautauqua yesterday.

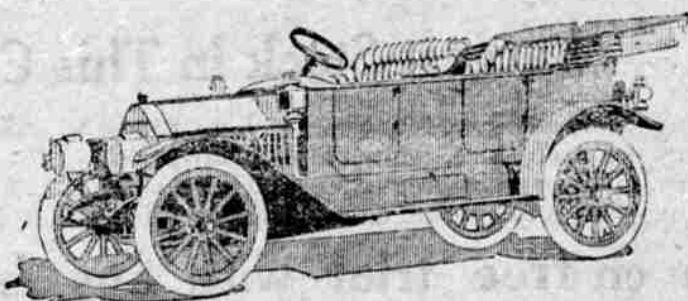
Mr. and Mrs. Wilmer Palmer, of Wellington, Ia., who have been visiting with Joe Palmer and other relatives, have returned home.

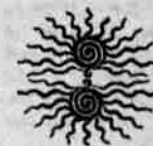

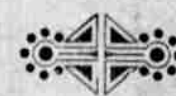
