

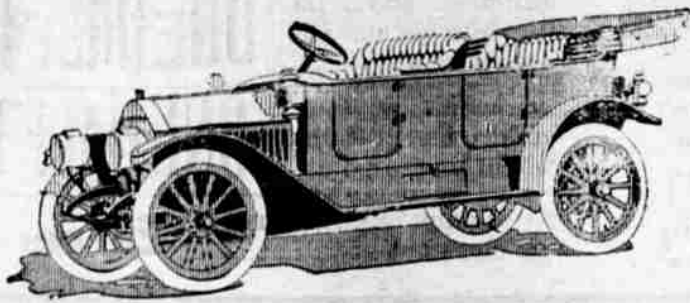
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TWILIGHTERS MAKE GO OF IT

La Grande's twilight league was permanently organized last night at a meeting in the La Grande National Bank building and the first game between the four clubs now comprising the league will be held Tuesday evening, commencing at 6:30 with the bankers and the Palmer mill company teams playing. On the following Thursday evening at the same hour the clerks and railroaders will mix and afford the fans a quintet at all the teams. The quartet of club was selected at a meeting of about 20 players who eliminated all fraternal teams for the present at least.

Business and System in Vogue.
 The league is created on business methods and system. The president, F. L. Meyers, the vice president, A. A. Wenzel, and secretary-treasurer, Mr. Claycomb, with a representative from each team, forms the board of

management and next Monday night this board meets to pass on players. No professional will be allowed to play, more especially to pitch and the aim of the management is to make the league a physical benefit, affording recreation and amusement for the players as well as making the clubs about evenly match in the matter of strength.

The admission was placed at 15 cents where mere expense only will be the necessary outlay of money and it is believed the low price will meet with favor from the fans.

The schedule is to be finally outlined at the meeting Monday night.
