SAW BIG PRICES PAID.

More Than Two-Year-Old Cows Bring
Close to \$70 Per Head.

Prices that reflect the confidence in the Grande Ronde cattle and horse market in the grade of stock produced yesterday on the Morrison and yesterday on the Henry Rinehart when what can be termed reasonable figures were paid for grade unregistered stock. One and a year old unregistered Jerseys

sold for \$60, and even as high as \$65 while two, three and four year olds, brought from \$70 to \$75 per head. In the opinion of cattle men this is unprecedented auction prices and the buyers were men who knew the cattle on sale. The bovines were unusually sleek as a consequence of the fine range and were all free from disease, a fact that still prevails all over the county.

Other Sales Equally Good.

A sale made last week carries out this same line of business. It consisted of nine grade cows to Charles Smith of Kelso at \$65 per head. This price is not the only unusual thing about the sale for in years past it has been the Grande Ronde buyers who had to go to Kelso to get what they wanted. Yearling grades are bringing \$40 per head, too, in instances.

Horses Bring Fancy Prices.

A carload of 16 head of horses was sold out of here last week for \$235-
