of May, 1912, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Spring avenue in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying on the south side thereof cement walk the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefited by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

to the south curb line of Washington avenue.

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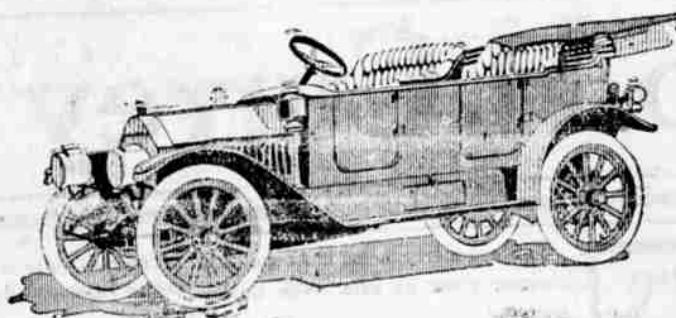


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
