

NEW BRIDGE NEARLY DONE

**SIDEWALK FIXTURES OF STEEL
WILL IMPROVE IT.**

Wide Structure Will Handle Enormous Traffic With Safety.

As imposing and as modern a bridge as Eastern Oregon boasts of is to be completed for public service at riverside park this week. A four-foot pedestrian bridge on either side of the wide driveway makes it very desirable for the congested service that results when park gatherings cross the bridge. There are graceful curves and lines to the bridge and imposing strength to the structure that makes it beautiful and extremely serviceable. Built at a cost of \$8,200 it does not represent a great outlay of money but has about it many features that make it a noteworthy structure. The final riveting is being done today and will be completed before the end of the week. John Synhorst and F. Depender are the riveters and experts who have seen the work done on the 2,800 rivets placed by them declare the job to be exceptionally good.

Width Is Attraction.

The bridge makes a straight connection between the street leading to the city and the county road beyond, and as the roadway over the bridge is 50 feet wide, it is exceptionally imposing. The fills leading up to the bridge proper are being put in by Contractor J. F. Campbell, so that when the riveters are finished all will be done.

New Style Is Evident.

The bridge has the Campbell-back truss with double strutters that are themselves doubly braced and bolted. The structure itself is 156 feet in length and rests on pillars of cement that are over 10 feet high and the roller bed on which the bridge rests is well supported. The structure expands and contracts daily, during the hot weather, about 1 and 3-4 inches and the rollers provide for ample expansion in any sort of weather. Excellent bracing has made the sidewalks on either side strong and firm and the railings will be of steel as are the sides of the main bridge, so that there will be no decay or destruction by accident or otherwise that might precipitate pedestrians or teams into the stream.

Over 20 workmen have been used in bringing the bridge to completion since the 27th of June. The bridge has a cement mixer, blacksmith shops and tool tents in connection so that practically all the work required on the bridge is done on the ground, curtailing expenses. The river bed is supplying the gravel needed to fill in the approaches and system and time savers are adopted for every department of the work. Superintendent Campbell has under him as foreman Frank Macklegun, an experienced bridge builder and when completed, the work will stand as a bridge model of Union county.

Reunion of Odd Fellows.
