

BLUE ROCKERS VISIT BAKER

LEWIS OF LA GRANDE MAKES A HIGH SCORE.

Baker Herald Relates Plans for Coming Shoots in Eastern Oregon.

(Baker Herald.) Messrs. Kiddle, Lewis and Quintan of La Grande, made up a party of shooters who visited the Baker club yesterday and joined in a friendly shoot here in the afternoon. A large crowd of Baker sportsmen took part, and a number of spectators attended. The shoot opened at 2:30 and lasted until 5:30 in the afternoon. It was because the shooters of La Grande came to Baker that the local club representatives who had expected to go to Sumpter were unable to go.

The La Grande delegation will join with the Baker Rod and Gun club and go to Sumpter for the shoot there on September 1. It is hoped by the La Grande sportsmen by this means that they can get a good crowd from both Baker and Sumpter on September 9 when they are planning to hold a tournament.

The highest scores were made yesterday by Mr. Lewis of La Grande and Messrs. Baldock and William Buby of this city, each scoring 22 out of a possible 25. The shoot was done in squads of four and five, the average score being considerably higher than it has been previously.
