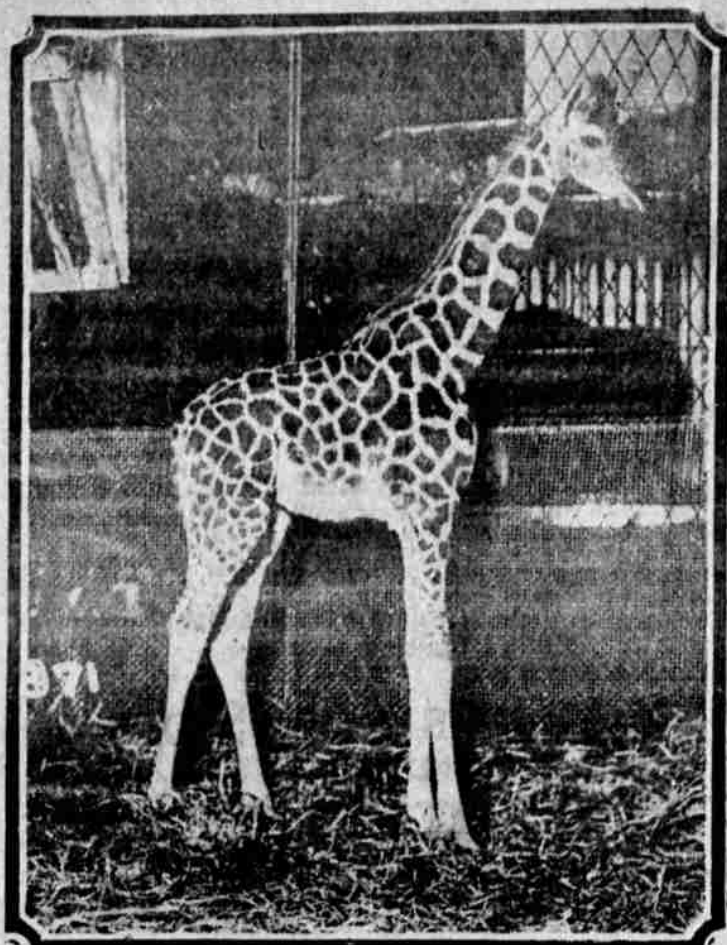


BABY GIRAFFE FEATURE OF BARNUM & BAILEY CIRCUS



A baby giraffe is the pride of the 110-cage menageries of the Barnum & Bailey circus, which will spread its acres of tents here for one performance on next Tuesday afternoon. The animal was born in the circus' winter quarters on January 31 last. No less an authority than Colonel Theodore Roosevelt predicted that she would not thrive, citing the cases of giraffes born in zoological gardens abroad and which survived only a few days.

The undaunted circus infant, however, has been one of the lushest inmates of the travelling zoo since the day she opened her eyes and toddled about the cage. Advance agents promise that she will be the cynosure of wondering crowds here. The Women's Political union of New York

City formally christened her "Miss Suffrage" during the circus engagement in that city.

There are several adult giraffes in the Barnum & Bailey menagerie. Aside from the circus beasts, the municipal zoos in New York and Cincinnati, O., contain the only giraffes in the United States, and under a recent ruling of the government none may now enter the country. The Barnum & Bailey management has refused a formal offer of \$40,000 from the London Geographical society for the sale of its herd.

The giraffe corral is a popular rendezvous for the superstitious circus folk. They want the beasts to lick their hands. Good luck, they think, is sure to follow.

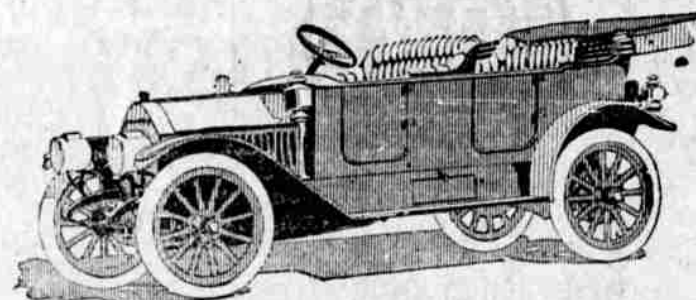
