ALL PUPILS CAN SEND EXHIBITS FREE OF FREIGHT.

O.-W. and Oregon Electric Makes Arrangements With State Fair People.

Arrangements for shipping free of cost all exhibits to the state fair at Salem by pupils of Oregon schools have been made by the O.-W. The railroad has offered these conditions for all exhibits, such as drawings, needlework, agricultural products, canned goods and preserves, poultry, live stock, or work of industrial schools, exhibited by pupils under direction of state board of education at the Oregon state fair, at fair grounds, Ore., will be transported by the O.-W. from all points on its lines in Oregon to the fair and return free under the following conditions:

- 1st. All exhibits will be restricted to "pupils" regular enrolled; and 1st. All exhibits will be restricted to represent the bona fide work of pupils regular enrolled and attending school within the state of Oregon.
- 2nd. All such exhibits must be concentrated and shipped from each school or school district under direction of Superintendent, principal, or other proper authorities must, in returned to original point of shipment handling must be under same conditions.
- 3rd. Exhibits will not be accepted under provisions of this arrangement when tendered by individuals, pupils or shippers, but must in all cases be forwarded under conditions as specified in Rule 2.
- 4th. Superintendents, principals, or other proper authorities must, in order to get benefit of the arrangement, place on bills of lading or shipping receipts the following notation over their signatures:
"Shipment contains exhibits of regularly enrolled pupils of school or school district for exhibition (and not
