HYDROPLANE FILM'S STAR

REMARKABLE FLIGHT TO OCEAN
A SHERRY'S CARD.

"The Money Kings" Three Reel Piece,
Has Spectacular Finish.

Wonderfully realistic use of a hydro-aeroplane, coming at the climax of a thrilling story, is pictured in a three-reel film to be shown at Sherry's. The title of the piece is "The Money King," and it is a Vitagraph feature, introducing the hydro-aeroplane in a most logical way. The features leading up to the hydroplane performance is itself out of the ordinary.

The picture shows that it is entirely possible for a president of the United States to place confidence in men who are unscrupulous enough to turn that confidence to their own profit at his expense. The basic idea in this three reel production is that of a young diplomat sent to represent his country at a Hague peace conference, having as its object the averting of an impending European war. His instructions from the president are to sue for peace at any and all events. Against the president's instructions there are large steel interests which would be deprived of stupendous orders for steel should the war not take place. The steel people's object under the circumstances is to forestall the influence of the president in settling the overtures for peace.

By a coincidence the young envoy selected by the president is the fiancé of the daughter of the steel baron who is a member of the president's cabinet. He is welcomed to that very wealthy man's family circle, which includes his nephew, an aviator who is

an expert in his line, and has recently completed a hydro-aeroplane which is a success. The young inventor takes great pleasure in exhibiting his flying machine, and, early in the picture, he is to be seen explaining to his fair young cousin and her fiancé the workings of his ingenious craft. It is while in the aviator's workshop that word comes to the young diplomat that he has been selected to represent his country at the Hague peace tribunal. His order is to sail for Europe forthwith, which he does.

Departure Brings Thriller.

But the way he sails is a thriller. It would be telling too much of the story to recite it all here, but there is a thrilling moment of indecision, in which right wins over parental love, and then comes the hydro-aeroplane to the front. How the machine is made to save the reputation of the envoy, restore the girl to her normal frame of mind, is beautifully told in the picture which has reserved the first portion of the story until the last. "The Money King" has a wide range of material to work with and has worked it out well. There is little use to describe the picture in detail; a glimpse at it from the comfortable Sherry theatre seats will well repay anyone.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 7th day of August, 1912, creating improvement district No. 66, and designating Greenwood avenue as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 7th day of August, 1912, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Greenwood avenue in said improvement district as hereinafter described by laying thereon gravel bitulthic pavement, the council will ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefited by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of Greenwood avenue from the north side of Washington avenue to the south side of Adams avenue.

(A) And the property affected or benefited by said improvement is as follows:

The east half of block 108 and all of block 109, Chaplin's addition and the west half of block 9, Coggan's addition, all in the city of La Grande, Oregon.

Notice is hereby further given that the council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefited by said improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$2,000.18. That the council will, on the 4th day of September, 1912, meet at the council chamber at the hour of 8 o'clock, p. m., to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.
