TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 7th day of August, 1912, creating improvement district No. 67 and designating Y avenue as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 7th day of August, 1912, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that said portion of Y avenue, in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying thereon macadam roadway, 40 feet in width, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefited by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made, that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of Y avenue, from the east line of North Fir street to the west line of North Spruce street.

(A) And the property affected or benefited by said improvement is as follows:

The south half of block 18 and 31; also the north half of blocks 19 and 30, all in Predmore addition to La Grande, Oregon.

Several Special Exhibits Add Much Attractiveness to Pavilion.

Although much too early in the year to bring forth the best that Union county can produce in the line of fruit and vegetables, still the exhibits at the Union county fair are such as any other county, would be only too glad to boast of. Several looked for community exhibits failed to appear, but those present are well worth paying a visit and seeing at first hand what our farmers can produce.

The Imbler exhibit of fruit and vegetables is one of the most striking and largest displays. Although so early in the season that many other sections thought it impossible to exhibit apples, yet this district has a show of various apples that bring forth the praise of the all we see it. Its vegetable display is of true merit and tells of the progressiveness of the citizens of that district.

The Eastern Oregon experiment station has a fine display of grains and grasses, Robert Withycome, superintendent of the station, personally arranged the exhibit and it serves in a way as a general Union showing.

Mrs. J. D. Slater has a beautiful table of flowers, mostly asters, and is almost alone as that kind of exhibitor. The La Grande Floral company has a very tastily arranged display. The Cove Milling company, with its many piles of well filled flour sacks hants at our industrial enterprises. The Y. M. C. A has a large and comfortable rest room in the building that is greatly appreciated by many each day.

The displays cover about all that can be produced and are of excellent quality, and everything considered, this being the first year, are probably sufficient in quantity.
