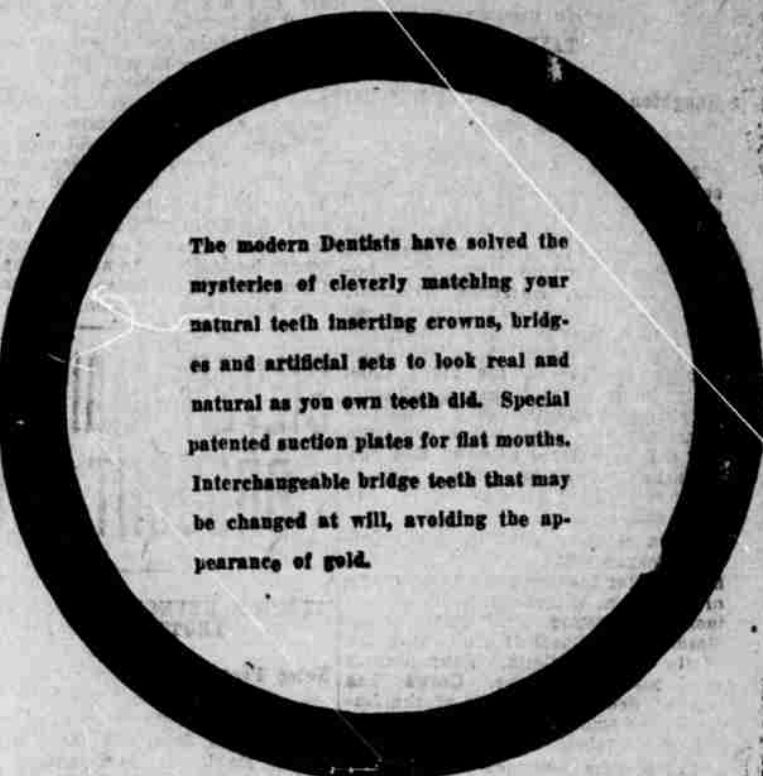
All that portion of O avenue, from the west line of First street to the West line of Fourth street.
