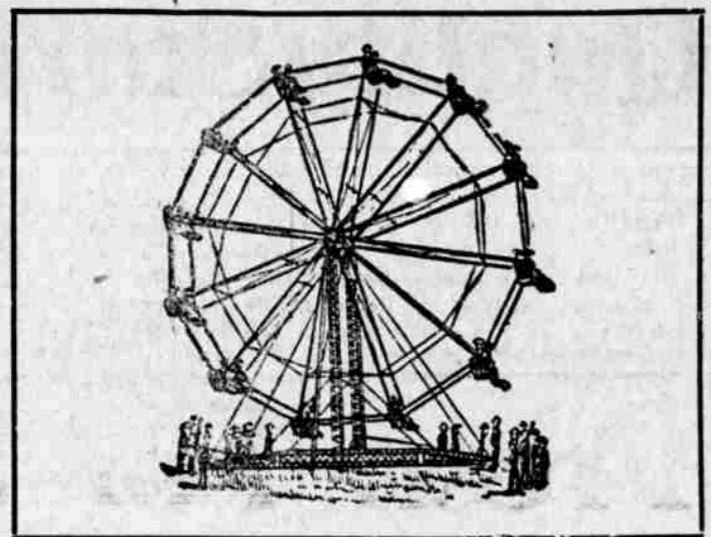

JOHN SPAIN IS INJURED AGAIN

JOHN DAY FAIR COMES NEAR BE-
ING END.

Horse Falls With Rider and Saddle
Horn Crushes Upper Part of Chest

Hard luck seems to be hovering about John Spain, popular Union county stockman and buckaroo who won the championship in the bucking contest at the 1911 roundup. Last July while giving an exhibition of steer roping he suffered an injury which caused the amputation of one of his hands and now comes the report that he has just had a narrow escape from death when an "out-law" which he was riding at the John Day fair fell and rolled with him. The following dispatch tells of the incident:

1911 Pendleton roundup, had a narrow escape from instant death. The horse he was riding, falling to throw its rider after repeated and bewildering stunts of bucking, suddenly threw out its head, dropped to the ground and rolled over, the horn of the saddle fortunately striking the rider far enough to one side to miss a vital spot. As it was Spain was seriously hurt, and lay on the ground unconscious for some time. The saddle horn crushed and lacerated the upper portion of his chest. Had it struck a few inches lower Spain's riding days would have been over.

1873—Oregon pioneer Association organized.

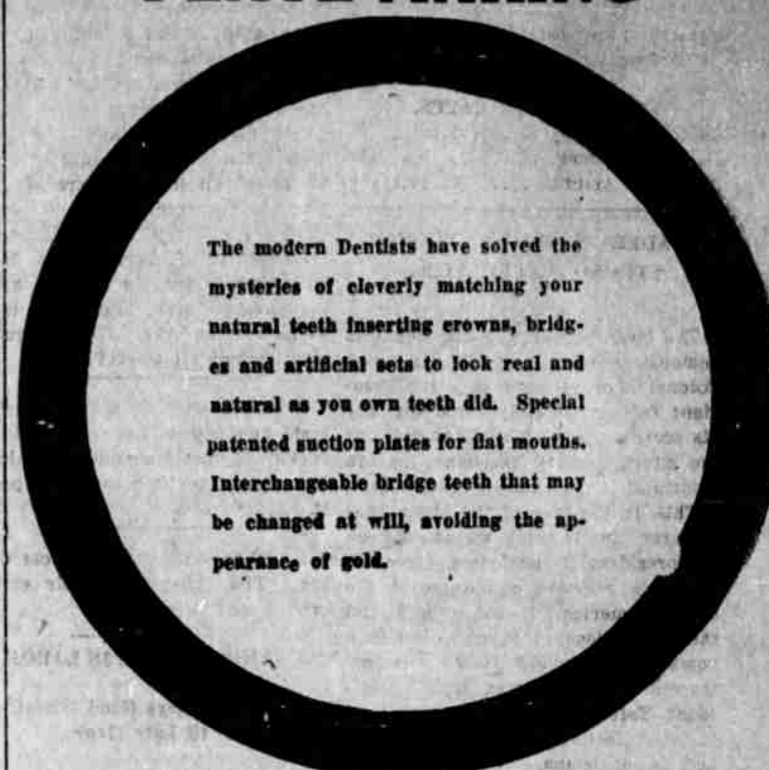
1876—University of Oregon at Eugene opened.
