RANCH EGGS UP TO FORTY CENTS A DOZEN.

General Scarcity—Bearish Tendency in Onion Markets, Too

Rapid rise in egg prices, ranch, fresh Eastern and storage, will probably be the most interesting feature of the local and state "necessaries" markets from now on until after the holidays. Not only are ranch eggs becoming scarcer here, but Wallowa hens are "on a strike" and it looks like the quotation of 40 cents now current will not remain good for long. All three grades of eggs are up five cents.

The onion market is bearish and potatoes, too, can be classed in that classification although the prices have not actually slumped below the six bits price. Onions are down to \$1.50. New home grown apples—75c per box.
