MORE PRESERVE PLANS MATURE

BURNT RIVER AND POWDER VALLEY SITES

Charles B. Oral Inspects Proposed Sections.

Within the next week or so large tracts of land on Burnt river and the Powder river south of town also on Powder river will be set aside as game preserves. Charles B. Oral, of La Grande, deputy game warden for this section of the state, has just returned from a trip to Burnt river on which he made arrangements with several of the farmers of that district to make their land preserves. Mr. Oral said this morning that there are several hundred acres in the present tracts of land to be set aside.

Fred Johnson, the Baker deputy game warden, has also made arrangements with the farmers just south of that city and the residents of North Powder river have voluntarily signified their intention to have their land set aside. According to the statement of Mr. Oral this morning this will be the last preserve made in this part of the country.

The process of stocking this territory set aside and to be set aside will be carried on immediately. The birds will be put in the different preserves for which they are best adapted. These, according to law, will be protected for a period of five years at the end of which time it is thought that the country will be well stocked with game birds.

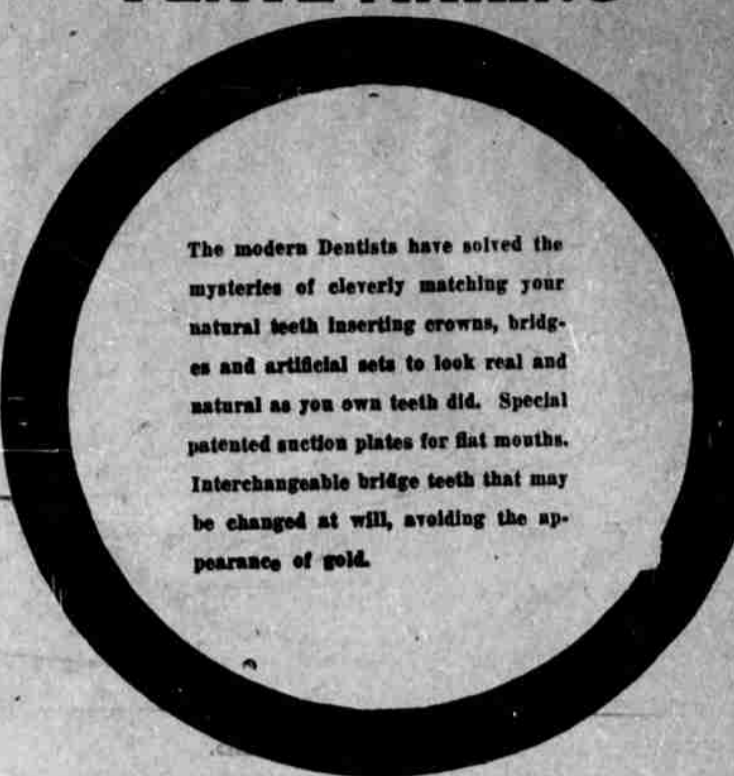
