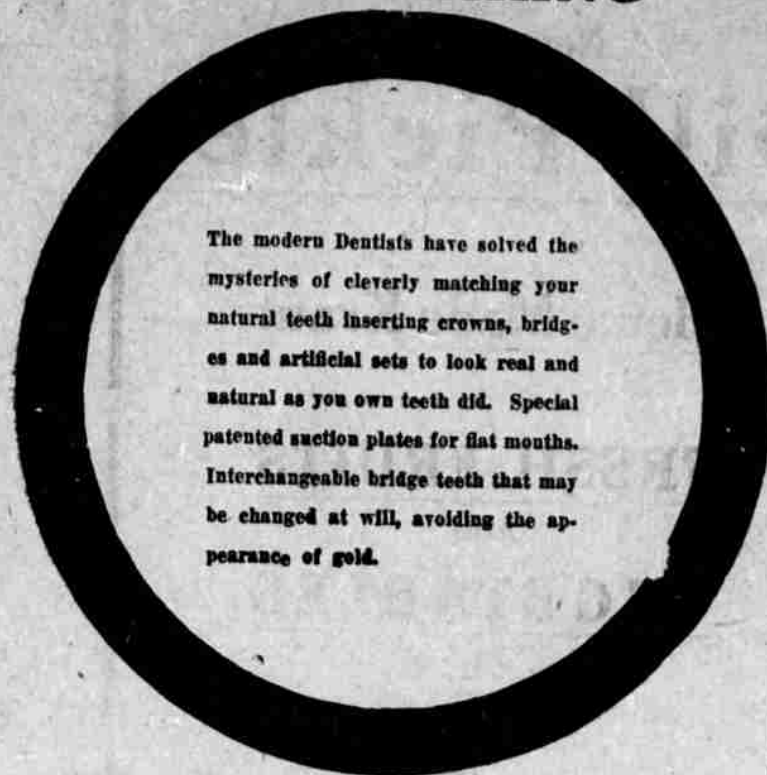

THE IMBLER-ALICEL FRUIT DISTRICT

Where the Grande Ronde Apples Grow—A Series of Articles Describing One of Eastern Oregon's Greatest Resources.

ARTICLE NO. 4.

Did you ever visit an apple orchard when the harvest was on? Well, it's worth while.

A few days ago a reporter for the Observer made the rounds at Imbler and Alicel and the sight was a revelation, even unto a citizen of La Grande who lives so near.

At the Thronson Fruit Company's orchard a number of people were employed picking apples, while many were busy in the packing department placing the fruit in boxes for storage until the market is such as to justify the owners to believe it has reached the high point.

The box maker at this plant makes 500 boxes a day and he is a busy boy from the time he starts until he quits. The expert packers are from Milton, Oregon, a fruit section that has long been organized and developed talent along these lines. The most expert of the packers gets about one hundred boxes daily to her credit, which at 6 cents a box nets the packer a very nice salary.

Per Centage of Extra Fancy.

Apples are like everything else—they go by grades. The extra fancy is the perfect apple showing 50 per cent color, the stem remaining in and wholly free from blemish. The fancy apples may have the stem out, have a small blemish, but must have size and color.

When the reporter visited this orchard the packers were busily engaged in packing Newtowns and Rome Beauty and it was surprising the small amount of anything but extra fancy and fancy stock that was to be seen. Seemingly nature has tried to furnish this district with every element that will produce the extra fancy apple, and that is the kind the grower rests his case upon. For no matter what the general price of apples may be he always knows there is a good price for the extra fancy.

When the box is filled and the lid nailed down it is carted to the ware house and those warehouses are a sight to see at this time of the year.

Tier after tier of boxes until one would naturally think that the Imbler Alicel district raises enough apples to supply the whole world.

Trees Seven Years Old.

The trees from which most of the fruit was taken are but seven years old. They stand in perfect rows like sentinels and the careful pruning and spraying makes them all look alike. In some cases tree surgery has been adopted. Where a tree bears too heavily and breaks a limb the orchardist runs a bolt through and perhaps suspends the limb by a wire from the main portion of the tree. The wound when wrapped with tire tape grows nicely together and the following season there is little or no trace of the break.

Alfalfa Between Trees.

In the Thronson orchard alfalfa is raised between the trees and this year three cuttings made an average of six and one half tons to the acre. The fact that alfalfa grows well is a proof of the claims of subirrigation for without water close by alfalfa is a plant that will not develop.

The early frost this season decidedly helped the fruit in the Imbler Alicel district because it assisted in giving a rich deep color. In most localities a frost at the time we had one this year would have brought serious results, but in this district where the trees experience hardy weather from planting the frost is withstood in a remarkably satisfactory manner. Take the Gano apple, for instance, and there are thousands of Ganos around Imbler, the color this year is the best ever known in Eastern Oregon. The frost, it is claimed by those who know, materially assisted the Gano. The seven year old Gano trees made an average of ten boxes to the tree and ninety-five per cent of the crop is perfect fruit.

Can this be beaten any place in the world? Whether the land is priced at \$500 an acre or \$2000, you can't beat this Gano yield of perfect fruit.
