FIGHT FOR GREAT FORTUNE

Descendants of Jacob Wertz Trying to Obtain 185 Millions.

Harisburg, Pa., Oct. 25.—At the old Wertz homestead near this county, founded by Jacob Wertz, head of the American branch of the family, in the 18th century, a reunion of the American descendants of Jacob Wertz, who are incorporated under the name of the American Wertz Family association, was held today, for the principal purpose of raising money with which to carry on the fight for the recovery of the estate of Paul Wertz, estimated at \$185,000,000. Paul Wertz was an imperialist field marshal of the seventeenth century and left an enormous estate which the heirs will make an effort to recover by appealing to the highest courts of Germany, Austria and the Netherlands.
