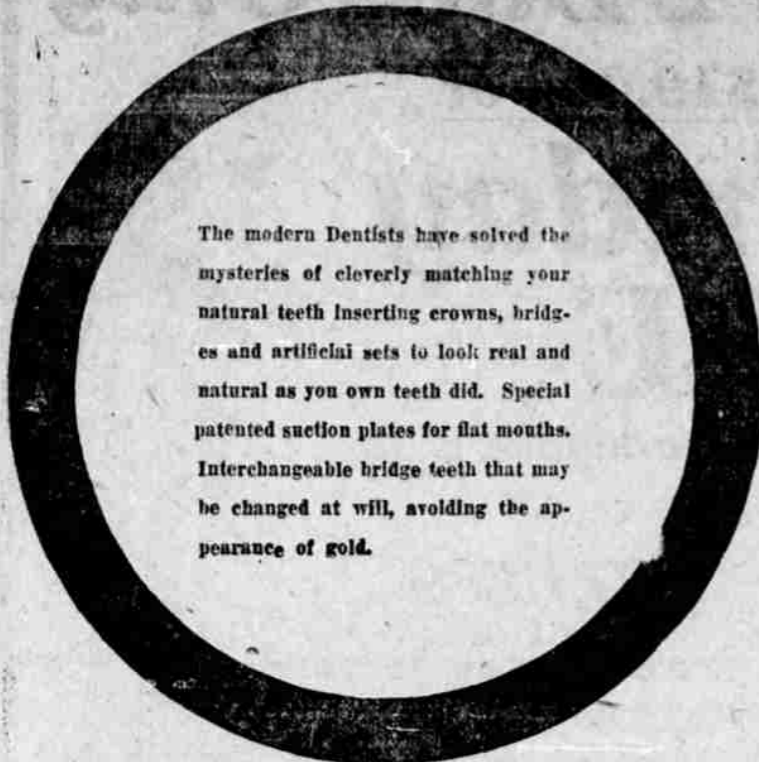

THE IMBLER-ALICEL FRUIT DISTRICT

Where the Grande Ronde Apples Grow—A Series of Articles Describing One of Eastern Oregon's Greatest Resources.

ARTICLE NO. 8.

After reading what is going on in the Sandridge country the question of land prices, actual profits, prices of fruit and other details become important.

In the first place permit this statement which will be borne out by proof: Fruit land prices in the Grande Ronde valley are the lowest in the whole northwest country.

When the first planting of commercial orchards was made there was established the price of \$150 an acre for planted land which included care of the trees for five years. Strange as it may seem this price has never been raised. The reason for it is this: Most of those who were the pioneers in the commercial orchard decided the fruit industry could get no better encouragement than to keep the price of the planted land down. There is a positive disposition and intention to make the Grande Ronde valley a fruit producing valley rather than a wheat producing section. This could only follow by attracting the investor here who wanted the first class orchard proposition and who was happily surprised that prices were so low. By mutual agreement of the owners in the Sandridge district the price of \$450 an acre has been retained, although understand there are many orchards in that section that could not be bought for twice that amount. And in several instances owners will not price their orchard lands.

Last year the prevailing prices for apples on board cars at Imbler and Alicel were: Newtowns, \$1.82; Rome Beautys, \$1.25; Gano, \$1.20; York Imperials, \$1.20. It takes but a few strokes of the arithmetical pencil to show the handsome profit from the orchards under these prices, and a few more strokes will show where a handsome profit will follow at much less prices than those. For bear in mind your expensive irrigation is eliminated on the Sandridge and several other matters that cost money in other fruit districts are not necessary here which go into the general profit column. The interest on your investment is cut down by half or more, which is no small item. The simplest problem in the world is—when proven orchard land is sold for \$450 why pay \$1200 an acre for it? That is the problem you must take with you when you come from Hood River, Rogue River, or Yakima to the Sandridge.

As yet the prevailing price has not been established for this year's crop, although there are a number of smaller contracts being made. In California Newtowns are bringing this year \$1.25 per box in the orchard. At Payette, Idaho, the apple crop is bringing from \$1.10 to \$1.25 for the entire crop and an average of 41 cars per day are being shipped. You naturally will say "Why has the Sandridge not such contracts?" And the answer is the Sandridge is a new district, does not possess the advertisement.
