

S. S. UNION A POWER, ACTIVE

GREAT SCOPE AND RESULTS ARE
NOTED

Eastern Oregon Feels Benefits of the
Oldest Missionary Organization.

E. R. Martin, who addressed a large gathering at the union service in the Baptist church Sunday evening was a caller at the Observer office today. In speaking of the society he represents, Mr. Martin said, "This society is the oldest Home Missionary society in America. It is an incorporate body of individuals controlled by business men and came into existence as the result of a great national convention of denominational leaders, who came together to devise an agency to assist the churches in caring for outlying, mixed and frontier places. In the 88 years of its work this society has organized more than 125,000 Sunday schools with more than 5,500,000 members and in the past 10 years more than 100,000 converts and 1200 church organizations have gone into the established denominations."

"For twenty years the union has had a small force at work in this state but because of the great need an insistent demand has been made by Oregon for a larger force. As a result of this demand I came into the field to make a campaign for home support and more men and located K. E. Close at La Grande to care for Union county and adjacent territory. Other men have been located at other strategic points and the number is being steadily increased."

"Mr. Close found in the county more than 40 rural school districts without Sunday school and over 4000 children of school age not in any Sunday school. In an effort to meet this need Mr. Close has traveled some 3000 miles in rural districts visited more than 600 homes as a pastor, supplied good reading matter to needy homes. Sixteen Sunday schools, nine of which are in Union county, with some 700 members, have been organized."

"Last year," said Mr. Martin, "this Union work of the church in our rural district brought in larger returns for money and men invested than any other line of religious work in this world—and this amongst the people with whom we have to live, the secret being largely in getting to the people in the name of all churches and finding everywhere open doors and a ready welcome."
