SUDDEN SKYROCKET IN PORTLAND YESTERDAY.

Believed Nettle Apiece for Fresh Eggs Will Be Reality Soon.

A nickle apiece for Union county eggs before Christmas is not an extravagant venture. While country eggs are bringing "only" 40 cents in La Grande markets, the sudden rise in Portland to 50 and 55 cents yesterday will soon have its effects here and increased prices are to be anticipated. With October just closing and eggs threatening to reach the half dollar mark early in November, and Holiday trade sure to bull the market up to about five cents per, the probabilities are that few Oregon eggs will be used in the home where the weekly payroll is short of a fortune.
