EAGLE VALLEYS AND GRAPES GO

CONCORDS DISAPPEAR FROM THE MARKET.

Top Egg Market the Same but Storage Eggs Go up Today.

Concord grapes, as well as Eagle Valley tomatoes, are now a thing of the past and local grocers have nothing to offer in that line. True, an occasional tomato is found lying about the stores but the day of selling a good variety is over, and the same thing is true of the Concord grape. Both the tomatoes and the grapes had a flourishing season this year, selling freely and generally being of good grades.

Slight variation in prices of eggs is noted today with top quality remaining the same—Eastern and storage are the grades that crept up.
