TAFT CROWDED TO THIRD PLACE BY FORECASTS

WILSON AND ROOSEVELT LEAD IN MANY STATES

FEW STATES CONCEDED TO WILSON BY SAFETIES

Washington and California Said to Be Running Topheavy to Roosevelt—Western States Have Close Races—Wilson Claims Ohio—Record-Breaking Votes Expected Generally

Acushnet, Mass., Nov. 5.—The unofficial count of the vote here today showed more than 250 per cent gain for Wilson, but Taft carried the precinct by 104 votes. This town has always been the first to send in returns.

New York, Nov. 5.—Overabundance of Wilson confidence, and apparent certainty that Taft is going to run third with Roosevelt a close second, is the gist of the forecasts coming from the four corners of the United States in the general election today. "A sweeping landslide, the greatest in history," is the way Mr. Coombs of the National Democratic committee sizes the situation up today, and Senator Dixon of Montana issued the following statement for the Progressives:

"Even if the Progressive national ticket loses the party wins because we are sure to be second making us the dominant party."

Taft Third in Nebraska.

Lincoln, Neb., Nov. 5.—The indications in the race are that it will be between Roosevelt and Wilson for the electoral vote. Taft is a poor third. The Democratic state ticket will probably be elected. The rural districts are strongly for Roosevelt.

Bowery Vote Diligent. New York, Nov. 5.—The weather was sunny and a big early vote occurred with little scratching. Fifteen per cent of the bowery vote was polled the first hour.

Nevada Centers on Senator. Carson, Nev., Nov. 5.—Sardis Sommerfield, Progressives, and Key Pittman, Democratic, candidates for senator, are the center of the Nevada fight.

Arizona Suffrage Indicated. Phoenix, Ariz., Nov. 5.—The weather is perfect and a big early vote indicates a normal Democratic majority. It is indicated that suffrage is expected to carry.

Warren Wyoming's Fight. Cheyenne, Wyo., Nov. 5.—The heaviest vote in the history of the state is being polled. The Democrats and Progressives are fusing in an endeavor to defeat Senator Warren. The senatorial fight is foremost.

Connecticut in Doubt. New Haven, Conn., Nov. 5.—The presidential race is close, according to early indications. The Democrats and Republicans are both claiming the state by 15,000.

Colonel Is Washington Favorite. Seattle, Nov. 5.—Washington's seven electoral votes will probably go to Roosevelt. The polling indicates that the colonel is a topheavy favorite. Wilson looms up a dangerous second and Taft in third place. The gubernatorial fight is hot. The betting favors Hay and Hodge, but little money is wagered.
